


What happens if your Child has Symptoms of COVID-19?

Parents and guardians are expected to screen their children prior to coming to school. Please use the Ontario Ministry of Health's COVID-19 School and Child Care Screening Tool:

https://covid-19.ontario.ca/school-screening/
If a Student develops COVID-like symptoms at school, their parent or guardian will be contacted to pick them up. The student will stay in a designated room until they are picked up. Siblings within the household will be picked up as well, unless they are fully vaccinated and asymptomatic. From home, the student and their siblings will follow advice from the Ontario Ministry of Health's COVID-19 School and Child Care Screening Tool until they are advised to return to school.
