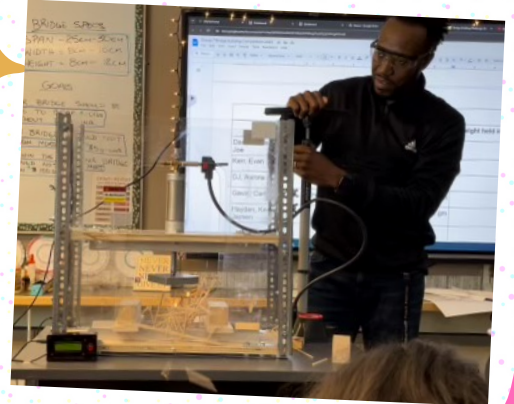

Students needing a new toothbrush can come to the office and get one. We have some available

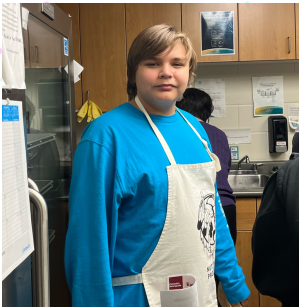
Bridge Building
